Updates to Auditorium gym: The Library and Community Club have asked the City to help with upgrades to the gym in the auditorium. The City Council agrees that the space needs to be updated and would like to help in the future after reviewing projected expenses.

Renew lease at Seed Building: Motion by Altendorf to renew the lease the City has with Stein Seed for \$1100 a month, increasing the monthly rent by  $100.2^{nd}$  by Joramo, all agree, motion passes.
